For students currently enrolled in Grades 5 – 11 And who have been identified as Gifted (as defined by the Ohio Department of Education)

ESC Applications due March 7, 2025 (OAGC Applications due February 15, 2025)

Dear Students, Parents, Teachers, and School Administrators,

To ensure fairness and consistency in awarding ESC Summer Enrichment Scholarships, we have established the following guidelines. Please read this information carefully before completing the application.

Eligibility:

This scholarship is for students currently enrolled in grades 5–11 who are identified as gifted, as defined by the Ohio Department of Education. We do not offer our own summer programs, but assist with tuition for established programs designed for gifted students. We fund academic or fine arts-oriented programs but do not fund sports camps, church camps, or school travel programs.

Funding Limits:

The scholarship amount will vary based on available funding and the number of applicants. Currently, the maximum awards are:

- \$500 for elementary students (grades 5–6)
- \$1,000 for junior high students (grades 7–8)
- \$1,500 for high school students

You may request the full amount needed, and if additional funds are available, we may consider a higher award.

OAGC Scholarship Requirement:

All applicants must also apply for the OAGC Scholarship Award. The OAGC District Contact must nominate the student, but classroom teachers or community members may write letters of recommendation. Please refer to the OAGC application instructions at the end of this letter.

ESC Application Requirements:

To be eligible for the ESC Scholarship, students must:

- 1. Be identified as gifted (per Ohio Department of Education guidelines)
- 2. Be nominated by a teacher, guidance counselor, or principal
- 3. Submit the following documents by the due date:
 - Nomination Form
 - Parent Release Form
 - Student Application Form

Additionally, students must submit:

- A copy of their OAGC application
- A brochure or web address for the summer program they wish to attend
- A typed and signed thank-you note for the sponsors

Notification of Other Funding:

It is the parent's responsibility to notify Sharee Price at the Gifted Services Office of any other funding sources immediately upon notification. If additional funding is received after our decision has been made, contact us immediately to adjust the scholarship amount. Failure to notify us of other funding will result in disqualification from future scholarships.

Failure to Attend the Program:

If a student fails to attend the program after receiving a scholarship, they will not be eligible for future ESC funding, unless extenuating circumstances apply. In such cases, the student or parent must submit a written explanation to the Gifted Services Office within two weeks of the program's start date.

Payment Process:

The ESC will pay the summer program directly. Parents must provide the address for the payment and an invoice from the program. If a parent needs to pay a registration fee before receiving the scholarship, reimbursement may be possible, provided the appropriate paperwork is submitted.

How to Apply for the ESC Summer Enrichment Scholarships:

1. Research Programs:

Before applying, research available summer programs and decide which one you plan to attend. A list of recommended programs can be found on our website at <u>https://www.scoesc.org/summer-enrichment</u>. Be sure to print a brochure or gather program details to include with your application. Many programs for 2025 will not post information until January 2025, so plan accordingly.

2. Commit to Attending:

Please do not apply unless you are certain you will attend the program. Awarding funds to applicants who later decide not to attend may prevent other students from participating.

OAGC Scholarship Application:

To apply for the ESC Scholarship, students must also apply for the OAGC Scholarship. **Do NOT send a copy of your ESC application to OAGC.**

- 1. Complete the OAGC Scholarship Application (available on our website or at <u>www.oagc.com</u>).
- 2. Ask the gifted contact at your district to complete the Nominator Form.
- 3. Request two letters of recommendation.
- 4. Write your essay carefully, as it will be reviewed by a statewide committee.
- 5. Make two copies of your completed application (one for your records and one for your ESC application).
- 6. Submit your OAGC application by the deadline of February 15, 2025.

The OAGC will issue scholarship checks directly to the program or university you're planning to attend, but will send the check to your home address. It is your responsibility to send the check to your chosen program.

ESC Scholarship Application:

- 1. Follow the guidelines in this packet and ensure all required items are submitted no later than March 7, 2025, at 3:00 PM. Late applications will not be considered and early applications are appreciated.
- 2. Submit your application by mail, email, or fax. If faxing, please call to confirm receipt.
- 3. The ESC will notify applicants by the end of April regarding scholarship awards.
- 4. If awarded, submit an invoice from the summer program so the ESC can process payment. If you must pay in advance, you may be reimbursed with proper documentation.

Scholarship Awards Reception:

Students receiving ESC scholarships should plan to attend the Scholarship Awards Reception at Morris University Center, Shawnee State University on Thursday, May 8, 2025, at 4:00 PM. This event is a chance to meet and thank the sponsors who make these scholarships possible. The reception will last approximately one hour.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Students currently enrolled in grades 5-11 who are identified as gifted or talented according to OAC 3301-52-15 in one or more areas: Cognitive Ability, Specific Academic Ability, Visual/Performing Arts, or Creative Thinking
- Students enrolled in one of the ESC's member districts (Bloom-Vernon, Clay, Green, Manchester, Minford, New Boston, Northwest, Notre Dame, Oak Hill, Portsmouth, Sciotoville Community, Valley, Washington-Nile, or Wheelersburg)

HOW DOES A STUDENT APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

- Applications must include ALL of the required materials. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Applicants must have successfully completed and submitted an application to OAGC by their deadline of February 15 (A copy of the OAGC application must be submitted along with the ESC application).

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD PROCEDURE

- Applications will be reviewed by a committee of teachers and administrators to determine awards.
- At the current time students should not consider a scholarship from the ESC that exceeds \$500 (for grades 5 & 6), \$1,000(for grades 7 & 8), or \$1,500 for high school students. However, students may request the entire amount needed and the committee will consider the request in the event of funding being available.
- Applicants will be notified whether or not they were selected to receive a scholarship by the end of April.

- ✓ Close the letter with gratefulness
- ✓ Be sure to "sign" your letter with your handwritten signature
